POLICY: PROVISION OF SUPPORT FOR CHILDREN WHO ACHIEVE PLACEMENT IN A NSW REPRESENTATIVE TEAM

1. Rationale

We believe that children who progress from St Michael's school through to represent Mackillop at a PSSA State Tournament and are then selected in the NSW state team could receive some assistance from the Parents and Friends Association.

2. Aim

To be seen to be just and fair to all children.

3. Implementation

- 3.1 In previous years the St Michael's P&F Association has provided monetary support to a number of children who represented NSW in particular sporting activities.
- 3.2 The Association could consider requests from children who achieve NSW representative level.
- 3.3 The Association will provide \$1000.00 that will be set aside to be divided at the end of the school year to children who satisfy the mentioned criteria.
- 3.4 No child will receive more than \$200.00 in one year.
- 3.5 If there are no claimants for the monetary support the funds will remain in the St Michael's Parents and Friends account.

4. Evaluation

The policy will be evaluated on a yearly basis.
