School Volunteers at St Michael's

In order to become a school volunteer at St Michael's Primary school, all parent / grandparent volunteers must complete a Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) Child Protection Training Course and Undertaking.

These requirements can be accessed via the St Michael's website. (*Please use the Internet explorer browser and not google chrome*) - http://www.stmichaelsbhills.catholic.edu.au. Click on Enrol Now, go to Parent Involvement, click on Child Protection Course.

You will then be directed to the CEDP website: http://childprotection.parra.catholic.edu.au/home

Complete Steps 1 and 2

- Step 1: Complete 'Building Child Safe Communities Undertaking for Volunteers' Form
- Step 2: Complete the online training module

Once you have successfully completed the training, an email will be sent to yourself and St Michael's for our records. These steps need to be completed every two years.

Teachers will send home a note regarding volunteering in the classroom. All volunteers will receive a Classroom Volunteer Handbook from their child's teacher.

Unfortunately if you offer to assist and have not completed all the volunteer requirements, you will not be able to assist until the volunteer requirements have been completed.

All volunteers need to sign in at the school office.

Explanation of Absences

CEDP promotes daily school attendance. Going to school every day is the single most important part of your child's education.

If your child is sick or absent you are required to notify their school on the first day of absence if at all possible. All explanations to the school must be provided within **7 days** from the first day of any period of absence.

Absences can be explained using one of the following methods:

- Online: log the absence directly using St Michael's Skoolbag App
- Email: the school at stmichaelsbhills@parra.catholic.edu.au
- Telephone: the school office on 9865 1600
- Note sent with your child



Where an explanation has not been received within the 7 day timeframe or the explanation has not been accepted, the school will record the absence as unexplained or unjustified on the student's record. The school will not be able to accept explanations which are not received within the 7 day timeframe.

Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- · being sick or having an infectious disease
- having an unavoidable medical appointment
- · being required to attend a recognised religious holiday
- exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral

Why do I need to notify the school if my child is absent?

Parents of children aged 6 to 17 years are legally required to ensure their children attend school every day or provide an explanation if they are absent. Notifying the school and providing an explanation for your child's absence will fulfil this legal responsibility.

The safety and wellbeing of students are the highest priorities for schools. Parents need to know if their child isn't at school, and schools need to know when and why a child is absent. Notifying the school of your child's absence helps ensure the safety and wellbeing of all children in school.

What is your responsibility?

- · Ensure your child attends school every day
- Notify the school immediately if your child is absent
- Provide an explanation for any absences within 7 days
- Make sure the school has your correct contact details so that you can receive attendance information about your child

With this in mind, we ask for your assistance in reminding your child that tapping on and off at the beginning and end of each trip is one of the conditions of using a School Opal card




